A complimentary tail gate will be held, Thursday evening at the home of Howard and Lise Simson.

Dead ducks or pheasants will be used in all stakes.

The judges will impose a system of rotation which will be used in the All-Age stake. Starting numbers will be the two digits including digits to the right of the decimal on the prior Tuesdays (Aug 1, 2017) TSX closing.

Judges shall have the power to disqualify any dog, which does not appear within 15 minutes of the time designated for its turn to be tested.

Dogs are required to run in order of the draw (males and females alike) unless excused by the marshal for that stake, or member of the Field Trial Committee.

Females in season may not compete. Refund of entry fee is subject to veterinary certificate.

KCK rules prohibit training on the grounds designated for the holding of a licensed trial. Private property is used for the trial and permission was obtained for Club use on this weekend only.

CKC rosettes and suitable prizes will be awarded to all dogs placing in each stake. CKC rosettes will also be awarded to dogs that earn a Certificate of Merit.

CKC Retriever Field Trial Rules and Regulations Chapter 21, Sect 21.7. It shall be the duty and obligation of the trail giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Retriever Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
