All entries must be accompanied by the entry fee in full, and all listing fees \$8.93 (includes 5% GST) where applicable. A listing fee as established by The Canadian Kennel Club must accompany the entry of a dog for which a Canadian Kennel Club individual registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN) is not shown on the entry form. **Scratches** will be refunded for a bitch in season totally. All other scratches will be refunded at the field trial committee's discretion, less a \$10.00 fee.

PLACINGS: First - 5 points, Second - 3 points, Third - 2 points, Fourth - 1 point.

PRIZE LIST: Standard CKC rosettes to the first four placings in each stake.
Certificates of Merit will be awarded at the Judge's discretion.

Ducks and/or Pheasants will be used in all stakes.

NOTICE TO COMPETITORS AND SPECTATORS

RULE 21.7 of the Field Trial Rules States: "It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Retriever Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue."

RULE 4.1.6 of the Field Trial Rules States: "The trial secretary shall assume the responsibility of collecting all listing fees for the CKC, which shall be stated in the premium list."

Non-Member Participation Fee: An annual non-member participation fee for awards (placings) and titles will be charged to all Canadian residents who participate in a CKC event but are not CKC members. The fee will match the ERN fee. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards (points) and titles to be cancelled. Once cancelled the awards, legs, points or titles will be given to the next applicable dog. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member.

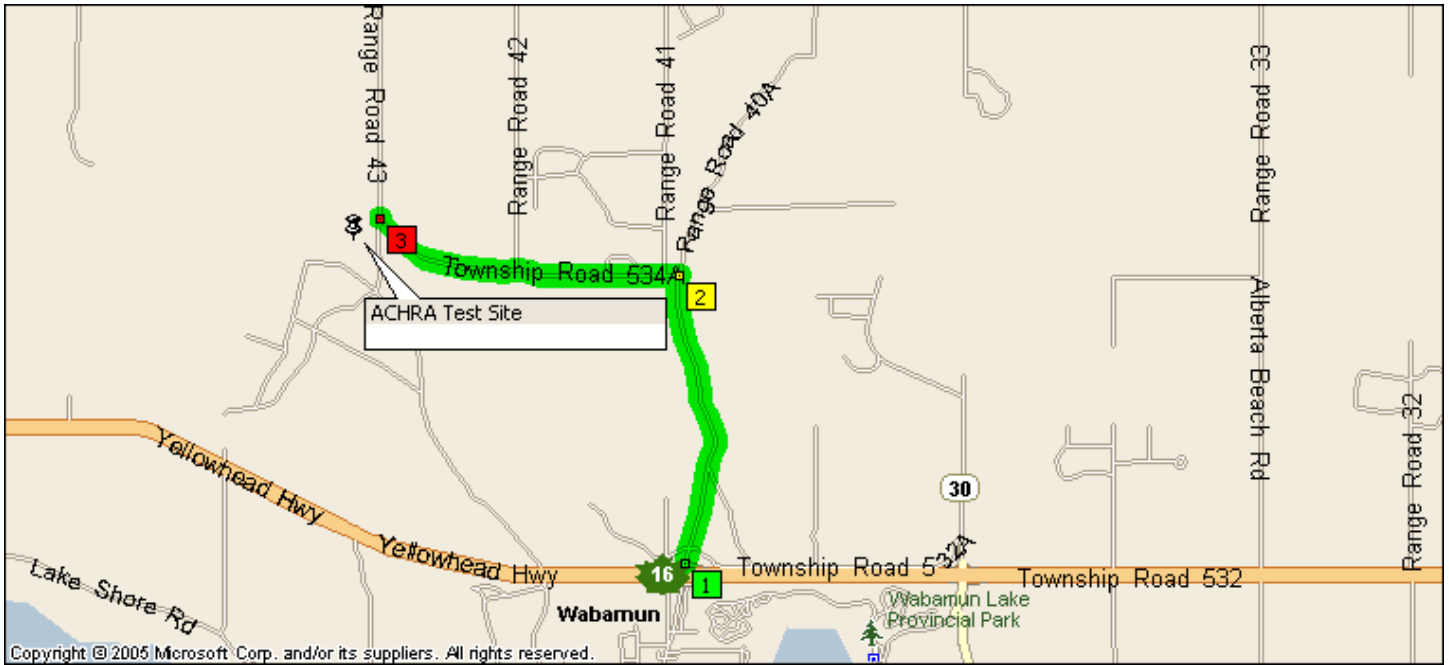
Release and Indemnification of Landowners and Alberta Retriever Clubs Association: By entering this event, each participant agrees to assume all risks and hazards incidental to participation in the event and agrees to release, save harmless and indemnify the owner(s) of the property upon which the event is held, together with their agents, employees and representatives from all claims, actions, costs, expenses and demands in respect to death, injury, loss or damage to the person, dog, or property of the participant howsoever caused, arising out of or in connection with the participant's use or entry upon the property. It is understood that this agreement is binding upon the participant and all of his heirs, executors and assigns.

MAP TO ARCA TRIAL GROUNDS

Travel West from Edmonton on Highway 16, (Yellowhead Hwy). Exit North off Hwy 16, at the Wabamun town exit (also signed for Whitewoods Golf). Head North 3 kms on Range Road 41 to Twp. Rd. 534. Head West on Twp. Rd. 534 for 3.3 kms. Turn left onto the gravel road, trial grounds is a small drive up the road, has a green gate at the entrance, on the right hand side.

****if you reach Whitewoods you have gone about half a kilometer too far****
