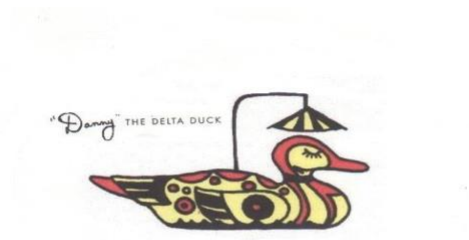

3. Entries **CLOSE 7:00 pm** Monday, August 13, 2018

4. The draw will take place at the residence of the Field Trial Secretary. **The starting dog number in the first series of the Open on Saturday and Sunday will be determined by using the last two digits at closing of the Toronto Stock Exchange (TSE) S&P/TSX composite index on the Thursday immediately preceding the trial . In All Age Stakes, a rotation will be used.**

5. A separate entry form for each dog in each stake is required. PLEASE USE THE OFFICIAL CKC ENTRY FORMS OR COPY OF SAME.

6. All entries must be accompanied by the Entry Fee (and, if applicable, Listing Fee) in full. A listing fee of \$10.50 (GST included) is payable unless the dog's entry carries a CKC individual registration number or ERN number.

7. **NO PHONE ENTRIES.**

8. **Scratches** will forfeit \$15.00. To be considered a "scratch" refunds must be requested in writing to the Field Trial Secretary no later than fourteen days after the trial, explaining the reason for the scratch.

DUCKS and PHEASANTS may be used in all stakes.

STANDARD CKC ROSETTES will be awarded for all placings in each stake. Standard CKC Rosettes will be for all CM's.

CAMPING AND TRAILER PARKING available, no services.

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Any person participating in any capacity at a field trial held under these rules shall not be subjected to an indignity of any kind during the progress of the trial, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the trial to see that this rule is effectively carried out. On report to the trial-giving club of an alleged indignity of any kind, the Field Trial Committee of the club shall forthwith conduct an investigation and shall at once render its decision to all parties concerned. It shall also within ten days after the trial, report to the CKC the nature of the alleged indignity, the names of the parties concerned and its findings. The Discipline Committee of the CKC shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of the report indicating that this rule has been violated.

Caution

The Delta Marsh Retriever Club will not be responsible for any loss or damage to any dog or to any equipment, whether the result of an accident or otherwise. Furthermore the Delta Marsh Retriever Club will assume no liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to event participants, bystanders, club members, workers or other individuals using the property for any purpose.

Release and indemnification of Landowners and the Delt Marsh Retriever Club

By entering this event, each participant agrees to assume all risks and hazards incidental to participation in the event and agrees to release, save harmless and indemnify the owner(s) of the property upon which the event is held, together with their officers, agents, employees and representatives from all claims, actions, costs, expenses and demands in respect to death, injury, loss or damage to the person, dog, or property of the participant howsoever caused, arising out of or in connection with the participant's use or entry upon the property. It is understood that this agreement is binding upon the participant and all of his heirs, executors and assigns.

DEFINITION OF STAKES

PUPPY	For dogs not over 1 year on the day of the trial
JUNIOR	For dogs not over 2 years on the day of the trial
QUALIFYING	For dogs who have never placed or had a certificate of merit in an Open All Stake, or placed in an Amateur All Age Stake, or won 5 Qualifying stakes
AMATEUR ALL AGE	For dogs over the age of 6 months and handled by an amateur as determined by the Field Trial Committee
OPEN ALL AGE	For dogs over the age of 6 months
