NRCC Fee: Effective 2018, the NRCC is taking a proactive role to ensure future funding for National events. At the end of the trial season, 100% of the funds collected will be distributed retroactively to the Host Club (s) for that year.

Entries received not using the current CKC entry form will be rejected.

An \$11.30 listing fee must accompany the entry form of any dog for which individual CKC registration or ERN number is not shown (this includes HST).

Please note: CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB CANIN CANADIEN Non-Member Participation Fee (Effective January 1, 2010)

Policy: Non-Member participation fee a.) An annual fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee. b.) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have the option to

become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply in 30 days of notification will result in all awards and titles being cancelled. c.) All Premium Lists will carry a note stating the fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-members and is not acceptable to CKC members.

Information: A nonmember resident in Canada is subject to the fee. Dogs co-owned with CKC member are exempt. There are 2 options for non-members: a.) Join CKC b.) Pay the non-member participation fee Dogs co-owned by 2 or more individuals, the first person listed in the CKC dog records will be considered the caregiver of the dog and all communication will be sent to this person. The fee is a yearly charge based on the calendar year January 1 to December 31 in which the awards, legs, points, titles, etc were achieved. It is not based on the number of dogs or titles or awards earned and is assessed against the owner (s). Non-members will receive a letter from CKC Head Office informing them that they have 30 days to join CKC or pay the Non-Member Participation Fee. Payment of the Non-Member Participation Fee or becoming a CKC member will protect all awards, points, titles and legs in the calendar year in which they were earned. Failure to pay the fee within 30 days of the notice will result in all awards, legs, points, titles being cancelled. Once cancelled the awards, legs, points or titles will be given to the next applicable dog. Once the cancellation takes place, any subsequent awards, legs, points etc earned will automatically be cancelled without further notice. The Non-Member Participation Fee is applicable starting at the first event in which the dog earns awards, points, titles, legs and is not prorated.

****Please note that the CKC Membership Application and the Non-Member Participation Fee forms are available on the website under CKC services and then Forms On-Line. If submitting a Membership Application, please ensure that you also complete the Non-Member Participation Fee form so that we are aware of the dogs involved *Refund of entry is subject to a veterinarian's certificate *Dogs and bitches will be mixed and run in order of the draw. *Dogs handled by the same person will be separated where possible**

Excerpted from the Retriever Field Trial Rule Book 6.6.2 The running order (the Draw) must be made and published (made public) prior to the date of the TSX closing number to determine the starting dog as per Section 6.6.3. Clubs holding the trial may not accept entries after the publishing of the running order. 6.6.3 In a stake carrying championship points the starting dog in the first series will be determined by using the last two digits at the closing of the Toronto Stock Exchange (TSE) S&P/TSX composite index (the TSX number) two days prior to the first day of the trial.

SWORTC is a member of the National Retriever Cub of Canada and dogs placing in our CKC approved Licensed Trial will be eligible to compete in National Stakes.

A copy of the following rules shall be prominently placed in every Premium List: "Any person participating in any capacity at a Field Trial held under these rules shall not be subjected to an indignity of any kind during the process of the trial and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the trial to see that this rule is effectively carried out. On report to the trial giving club of an alleged dignity of any kind, the Field Trial Committee of the club shall forthwith conduct an investigation and shall at once render its decision to the parties concerned. It shall also, within 10 days after its trial, report to the CKC the nature of the alleged indignity, the names of the parties concerned and its finding. The Discipline Committee of the CKC shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on the report indicating that this rule has been violated."
