IN ORDER TO PROTECT ANY AWARDS OR TITLES NON –CKC MEMBERS WILL BE GIVEN A CHOICE TO BECOME A MEMBER OR PAY A FEE, OTHERWISE, AWARDS & TITLES WILL BE CANCELLED.

"It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Retriever Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred"

Judges will impose a system of rotation thereafter in the all age stakes. Dogs will run in order of the draw with sexes mixed. Running order will rotate in the Open & Amateur stakes.
