### **DEFINITION OF STAKES**

**PUPPY** For dogs 6 month of age but not over 1 year on the day of the trial  
**JUNIOR** For dogs not over 2 years on the day of the trial  
**QUALIFYING** For dogs how have never won 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> or a certificate of merit in an Open All Age stake nor a 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, or 4<sup>th</sup> in an Amateur All Age Stake nor have won 5 Qualityings  
**OPEN ALL AGE** For dogs over 6 months of age

AMATEUR ALL AGE For dogs over 6 months if handled by a person deemed an Amateur by the Field Trial Committee

### **MANITOBA COVID 19 GUIDLINES FOR FIELD TRIALS**

Please read the following guidelines which have been established to promote health and safety of everyone during this pandemic. **It is assumed that sending in your entry means you accept and will abide by all Manitoba Provincial recommendations dealing with Covid 19.**

1. Club officials and participants are required to follow all guidelines that apply. If at the time of the draw Provincial travel restrictions still apply entries from east of Terrace Bay, Ont. will not be accepted unless all participants have self-isolated for the required 14 days.
2. Practice social distancing. Avoid congregating to the extent possible. Gallery must practice social distancing – 6 feet between chairs.
3. Avoid shaking hands or hugging.
4. Avoid touching dogs or equipment that is not yours or your responsibility.
5. Park with sufficient distance between vehicles.
6. Remain near your vehicle until just prior to running and follow marshal's instructions regarding running order and entering holding blinds.
7. Any special instructions from the judges will be posted in the last holding blind.
8. Handlers will be invited to the line in small groups. You may not see the test dog run but will see other dogs run from the holding blinds.
9. Gloves must be worn by handlers.
10. Birds will be placed in a pail by the handler and dealt with by the marshal when the handler and dog leave the line.
11. Hand sanitizer will be available, please use it.
12. All handlers should bring their own radio as this is how the marshal will communicate when it is your turn to enter the holding blind and other handler instruction
