## **ENTRIES**

**The Qualifying and Junior will be run together, therefore, dogs cannot be entered in both stakes on the same day.**

**Time permitting, minor stake dogs will be allowed to run all tests after they have been eliminated.**

1. Make cheques, dated no later than the closing date, payable to the Manitoba Gun Dog Association. **Please mail early.**

3. Draw at 8:00 PM on Monday, August 24th, 2020 at the home of the Field Trial Secretary.

4. All dogs will run in the order drawn. In All Age Stakes rotation will be used. The starting dog in the first series of the All-Age stakes will be determined by using the last two digits (including digits, if any to the right of the decimal point) of the closing S&P/TSX composite index (the TSX number) on Thursday, August 27th, 2020.

5. A separate OFFICIAL CKC ENTRY FORM for EACH DOG in EACH STAKE is required.

6. All entries must be accompanied by the entry fees and, if applicable, a TCN fee. Dogs not registered in Canada (CKC registered or with an ERN) must obtain a TCN before submitting an entry for a field trial. TCNs can be obtained from the CKC online, by paper application, or by contacting the Shows & Trials division toll free at 1-855-364-7252. A TCN fee of \$10.50 must be included with your entry for the trial. CKC Registration or ERN must be applied for within 30 days of the trial or all awards will be cancelled.

7. **No phone entries.**

**Non Member Participation Fee** “these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by Canadian non CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.”

**SCRATCHES** will forfeit \$15.00. To be considered, “NO SHOW” refunds must be requested in writing to the Field Trial Secretary no later than fourteen days after the trial, explaining the reason for the scratch.

**DUCKS and/or PHEASANTS** may be used in all stakes.

**STANDARD CKC ROSETTES** will be awarded for all placings and CMs in each stake.

**CAMPING and TRAILER PARKING** available. No electrical hook ups; no water.

### IMPORTANT NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS AND JUDGES

#### 3.8 Indignities to a Judge

3.8.1 A judge officiating at a field trial held under these rules shall not be subjected to any indignities of any kind during the progress of the field trial. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the field trial to see that this rule is effectively carried out.

#### 3.9 Judge's Conduct

3.9.1 A judge must conduct himself in a manner that is fair and not prejudicial to the sport.

**21.7** It shall be the duty and obligation of the event-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities. The Retriever Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.

### Caution

The Manitoba Gun Dog Association Inc. will not be responsible for any loss or damage to any dog or to any equipment, whether the result of an accident or otherwise. Furthermore the Manitoba Gun Dog Inc. will assume no liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to event participants, bystanders, club members, workers or other individuals using the property for any purpose.

## **MANITOBA COVID-19 GUIDELINES FOR FIELD TRIALS**

Please read the following guidelines which have been established to promote the health and safety of everyone during this pandemic. **It is assumed that sending in your entry means you accept and will abide by all Manitoba Provincial Health recommendations dealing with Covid-19.**

1. Club officials and participants are required to follow all guidelines that apply. Safe Field Trial practices include actively encouraging all judges, workers, volunteers, and handlers if sick, to notify FT COVID-19 designee and stay/go home according to public health guidance. (Don't come to event if you are feeling ill or been in contact with COVID-19 positive person or have travelled outside of Canada or east of Terrace Bay, ON in the 14 days prior to the event).
2. If at the time of the draw Provincial travel restrictions still apply, entries from east of Terrace Bay, Ont. will not be accepted unless all participants have self-isolated for the required 14 days. (Proof may be requested).
3. **Practice social distancing at all times.** Avoid congregating to the extent possible. All individuals must practice social distancing by maintaining at least 2m (6 ft) between chairs.
4. Avoid shaking hands or hugging.
5. Avoid touching dogs or equipment that is not yours or your responsibility. Only designated workers shall handle equipment.
6. Park with sufficient distance between vehicles.
7. Remain near your vehicle until just prior to running and follow marshal's instructions regarding running order and entering holding blinds.
8. Any special instructions from the judges will be posted in the last holding blind.
9. Handlers will be invited to the line in small groups. You may not see the test dog run but will see other dogs run from the holding blinds.
10. Birds will be placed in a pail/on bird rack by the handler and dealt with by the marshal when the handler and dog leave the line.
11. Wash hands regularly with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, when available; otherwise, use hand sanitizer.
12. Food and Beverage will not be provided by the FT committee and there will be no tailgate party.
