A \$11.30 fee must accompany any entry form of dogs for which an individual CKC registration or ERN number is not shown. A Temporary Competition Number (TCN) may be obtained by contacting the CKC. Separate entry forms must be completed for each stake the dog is entered. Scratches/refunds for dogs withdrawn after the closing date for reasons other than stated in the CKC Retriever Field Trial rule book will not have their entry fees refunded. Canadian residents who are non-CKC members running a wholly owned dog cannot be awarded a placement unless they pay a non-member participation fee or membership fee to the CKC.

PLEASE NOTE A temporary competition fee as established by The Canadian Kennel Club must accompany the entry of a dog for which a Canadian Kennel Club individual registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN) is not shown on the entry form.

Running Order: We will utilize the 2 ending digits in the TSX as of the close of business on Tuesday July 20, 2021 as a starting number for the first series in the all age stakes. Judges will impose a system of rotation thereafter in the all age stakes. Dogs will run in order of the draw with sexes mixed. There may be rotation in the minor stakes.

CAUTION: The Labrador Retriever Club of Central Ontario will not be responsible for any loss or damage to any dog or to any equipment whether the result of an accident or otherwise. Furthermore, The Labrador Retriever Club of Central Ontario will assume no liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to participants, bystanders, club members, workers or any other individual using any of the properties for any purpose.

Field Trial Officials will be enforcing COVID -19 related guidelines whenever possible, however, The Labrador Retriever Club of Central Ontario will not be held responsible for transmission of the novel coronavirus (SARS-CoV2) or any related illness due to Covid-19.

ATTENTION: Please read and familiarize yourself with the following COVID-19 guidelines. The Labrador Retriever Club of Central Ontario will assume that by submitting your entry that you accept and will abide by all Ontario Provincial recommendations with regards to COVID-19. These guidelines may be amended or altered by the club as required.

1. Club officials and participants are required to follow all guidelines that apply.
2. Practice social distancing. Avoid congregating in groups as much as possible. Gallery must practice social distancing - 6 feet between chairs.
3. Avoid shaking hands and hugging.
4. Avoid touching dogs or equipment that does not belong to you or is not your responsibility.
5. Park with sufficient distance between vehicles.
6. Follow the marshals instructions regarding running order and entering holding blinds.
7. Any special instructions from the judges will be posted in the holding blind.
8. Handlers will be invited to the line in small groups. You might not see the test dog run but will have the opportunity to see other dogs run from the holding blinds.
9. Gloves must be worn by handlers
10. Birds will be placed into a bucket or onto bird rack by the handler and dealt with by the marshal once the dog and handler leave the line. Follow the instructions from the marshal.
11. Hand sanitizer will be available.
