NO POST DATED CHEQUES accepted. ALL NSF cheques are subject to a charge of \$20.00. N.S.F. Cheques are considered Non-Payment of entry fees and are punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. All fees must be paid before the tests.

Attention Foreign exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you.

ATTENTION ALL CANADIANS WHO ARE NOT CKC MEMBERS

Effective January 1, 2011, the CKC has instituted an annual Non-Member Participation Fee for awards and titles for a CANADIAN non-member of the CKC. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by a non-CKC member and are not applicable to CKC members. Non CKC member participants must either purchase a CKC membership or pay the non-member participation fee within 30 days of notification or the CKC will cancel any awards and titles. Each dog may only be entered in ONE of the WC, WCI or WCX test. A dog must have a WC title before entering the WCI test, and have achieved a WCI title before running the WCX test.

Bitches in season **MAY NOT** compete in the tests.

Entry and listing fees paid for any dog withdrawn because of a bitch being in season, injury, illness or death shall be refunded in full. An appropriate veterinary certificate must be given to the Test Secretary **BEFORE** the start of the tests to qualify for a refund.

Catalogue order will be determined by draw on **June 9** for the **June 17**, test and a second draw will be held on **June 17** for the test on **June 18**. This will be the running order, unless prior arrangements are made with the Field Marshall.

Ducks will be used for both the land and water marks.

All Bird Boys, Judges and Competitors should wear dark or camouflage clothing. Handlers shall not wear white or light coloured at any time, but handlers may wear handling jackets for the blinds in WCX.

All qualifying dogs will be awarded a CKC rosette.

There will a designated area (land and water) available for airing your dog(s) on the test grounds. Contact the Field Marshall upon arrival at the test site to confirm location of both prior to airing your dog(s).

The Test Committee is pleased to offer coffee and tea in the morning. A BBQ lunch will be available on site.

upon the property. It is understood that this agreement is binding upon the participant, or his/her heirs, his/her executors and assigns.

Section 14.7 CKC Working Certificate Test Rules and Regulations

It shall be the duty and obligation of the event-giving club to that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities. The Working Certificate Committee Chair shall promptly report any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such actions as it deems fit on the receipt of that report indicating that this has occurred.
