ENTRIES

The Senior and Junior will be run together; therefore, dogs cannot be entered in both stakes on the same day.

1. Cheques should be made payable to *The Manitoba Gun Dog Association* and must be dated no later than the closing date (June 11, 2018).

4. Draw at 7:00 PM on Wednesday, June 11, 2017 at the home of the Hunt Test Secretary.
5. All dogs will run in the order drawn.
6. Separate OFFICIAL CKC ENTRY FORMs are required FOR EACH DOG in EACH STAKE.
7. All entries must be accompanied by the Entry fees (noted above) and, if applicable, the Listing fees. A Listing fee of \$10.50, including GST is required per dog and per event unless the dog's entry carries a CKC individual registration number or ERN number.
8. "Day of" entries and phone entries WILL NOT be accepted.

NON CKC MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by Canadian non CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members."

SCRATCHES will forfeit \$15.00. To be considered, "NO SHOW" refunds must be requested in writing to the Hunt Test Secretary no later than fourteen days after the trial, explaining the reason for the scratch.

DUCKS and/or PHEASANTS may be used in all stakes

CLOTHING In keeping with the aim of simulated hunting conditions and situations, handlers, judges, workers, and other test participants shall be attired in dark or customary hunting attire, which adequately reflects a waterfowling or upland hunting environment and provincially required blaze orange for the upland test, where applicable.

STANDARD CKC ROSETTES will be awarded for all qualifying dogs.

CAMPING and TRAILER PARKING is available. However, there are NO electrical hook ups and NO water.

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS AND JUDGES

3.8 Indignities to a Judge

3.8.1 A judge officiating at a hunt test held under these rules shall not be subjected to any indignities of any kind during the progress of the hunt test. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the hunt test to see that this rule is effectively carried out.

3.9 Judge's Conduct

3.9.1 A judge must conduct himself in a manner that is fair and not prejudicial to the sport.

20 Discipline

20.7 It shall be the duty and obligation of the event-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at a hunt test held under these regulations, is not subject to any indignities. The Hunt Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.

Caution

The Manitoba Gun Dog Association Inc. will not be responsible for any loss or damage to any dog or to any equipment, whether the result of an accident or otherwise. Furthermore the Manitoba Gun Dog Inc. will assume no liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to event participants, bystanders, club members, workers or other individuals using the property for any purpose.

Release and indemnification of Landowners and the Manitoba Gun Dog Association Inc.

By entering this event, each participant agrees to assume all risks and hazards incidental to participation in the event and agrees to release, save harmless and indemnify the owner(s) of the property upon which the event is held, together with their officers, agents, employees and representatives from all claims, actions, costs, expenses and demands in respect to death, injury, loss or damage to the person, dog, or property of the participant howsoever caused, arising out of or in connection with the participant's use or entry upon the property.
