- No paper entries will be accepted.
- **UPDATED: With Ontario opening to Phase 3 on July 16, 2021, we are adjusting our limit to 25 dogs each day.**
- COVID protocols and public health direction will override these limits if necessary.
- This premium list will be updated on Dogshow.ca if any change is needed.
- **Entries will open July 26, 2021, at 7:00 pm and close when full or, July 30, 2021 at 7:00pm, whichever comes first.**
- **Do not delay! A wait list will be maintained in the event of scratches.**

## PAYMENT

- A \$11.30 (HST included) listing fee must accompany any entry form for dogs without an individual C.K.C. registration or ERN
- Scratches/refunds for dogs withdrawn after the closing date, for reasons other than stated in the C.K.C. Hunt Test rule book, will not have their entry fees refunded
- All fees to be in Canadian funds, no exchange will be given on U.S. funds

## DIRECTIONS TO HEADQUARTERS AND TEST

From 401 at Exit 705. Take Exit 705 off the 401. Head northwest toward Concession 2 Rd. Turn right onto Concession 2 Rd (signs for County Road 15/Maitland Road). Turn left at the 1st cross street onto County Rd 15 (signs for County Road 15 N/Maitland). Turn right onto Carleys Corners Rd. Destination will be on the right.

## GENERAL INFORMATION – MUST READ

- **Entries:** Entries will be accepted only through [www.dogshow.ca](http://www.dogshow.ca). Owners are responsible for errors on online entry forms. No phone, faxed, emailed, late or day of entries will be accepted. A separate entry for EACH dog in EACH test is required on the online form provided by [www.dogshow.ca](http://www.dogshow.ca). ERNs (Event Registration Numbers) for foreign born or foreign owned dogs can be obtained from the CKC. ERNs must be applied for within 30 days of entering a CKC event. Contact [anna.morison@donamor.ca](mailto:anna.morison@donamor.ca) or 613-658-5893 before 9:30pm for information. **Email inquiries preferred.** No entries will be accepted after the closing date.
- **Listing Fee:** A \$11.30 (including HST) listing fee as established by the CKC must accompany the entry of a dog for which a CKC individual registration, Event Registration Number (ERN) or Performance Event Number (PEN) is not shown on the entry form.
- **Canadian Resident Non-CKC Member:** Important: The Non-Member Participation Fee applies to dogs wholly owned by a resident of Canada who is not a member of the CKC; it is not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the Non-Member Participation Fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. (For a Membership application, please go to [www.ckc.ca](http://www.ckc.ca) under CKC Services and Forms On-Line). The Non-Member Participation Fee is fee paid in the calendar year (January – December) in which the dog achieved its title and/or titles. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact CKC Head Office.
- **COVID Protocols:** As set forth by the LGHU/EOHU will be in place. Maintain social distancing in the handler's gallery and during handler meetings. Wear your mask until you are on line with your dog, facing away from the judges. Place retrieved birds as directed.
- **Marshal:** The marshal is in control of the stake. Do not approach the judges directly. Ask questions during the handler's meeting at the start of each test. Otherwise, direct inquiries through the marshal. Please check in with the stake marshal upon arrival. The marshal has the authority to move dogs for the efficiency of the test. Please get your dog promptly and report to the holding blind when asked to do so.
- **Request to Assist:** We are a small club, so please be advised that the Marsal may request that you help out by operating a gun station, when you are not running. Please pitch in if asked.
- **Rules:** Hunt Test Rules and Regulations Books are available from the Canadian Kennel Club, 200 Ronson Drive, Suite 400, Etobicoke, ON M9W 5Z9 or downloaded from [www.ckc.ca](http://www.ckc.ca)
- **Awards:** Official CKC Rosettes will be awarded to all qualifying dogs at the end of the test day at the test site.
- **Catalogues:** Catalogues and maps will not be available on site. Please print out your
- **Refunds:** Entry fees will not be refunded after Friday July 30, 2021. In the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a judge or barred from competition by action of the Test Committee or the Canadian Kennel Club, no refund of entry will be made. Bitches in season are NOT eligible for entry and are not allowed on the test grounds. Bitches may be subject to vetting. Entry and listing fees paid for any dog withdrawn because of estrus, illness or death shall be refunded in full if notification in writing is accompanied by a veterinarian's certificate. All refunds must be requested in writing and once the catalogue has been printed, will be less CKC event fees and listing fees if applicable.
- **Running Order:** Running order will be drawn at the home of the Test Secretary. Males and females will be run in the order of the draw or at the discretion of the Marshall. **Running orders and test site address, plus a digital copy of the catalogue will be posted to [www.dogshow.ca](http://www.dogshow.ca) after closing. Printed copies of the catalogue will not be available on site. Do not attend a test site unless you are handling a dog that is entered in that stake. Due to gathering size limits, no unentered spectators are to be at test sites: handlers, workers, and judges only, please.** The running order will be posted on the EORC website [eorc.jimdo.com](http://eorc.jimdo.com) after the draw. Please check there to confirm receipt of entry.

- **Start Times:** Start times will be adhered to as strictly as possible and handlers are asked to be at their stake and checked in with their Marshall a minimum of 15 minutes prior to start time regardless of running order.
- **Clothing:** All handlers and spectators shall wear hunting attire, dark or camouflage clothing.
- **Birds:** Game birds will be used.
- **Guns:** Shotguns may not necessarily be used; however, handlers may be required to handle a gun or a replica during the test. Gun safety is considered part of the test.
- **Grounds:** CKC Hunt Test Rule Section 2.5.1 – “There shall be no training of dogs on the grounds of a hunt test, except for single training bumpers which are thrown by hand by the handler, either within 24 hours of the commencement of the event, or at any time during the event. The Hunt Test Committee is responsible for enforcement of this provision.” All dogs when not running in their test MUST be on leash and under control. Bring adequate shade, sunscreen, water and cover for hot or rainy weather for both you and your dog(s). Be prepared and carry a first aid kit. YOU MUST pick up after your dog and airing is only allowed in areas designated by Hunt Test Headquarters and Test Marshalls. Please respect the landowners that have so graciously allowed us on their land by obeying all signs, removing all garbage and debris. Close all gates behind you and park ONLY in designated areas.
- **Collars:** CKC Hunt Test Rule Section 2.5.2 – “Electronic collars (either dummy or live) as well as prong or pinch type collars shall not be worn by a dog on the grounds of a Hunt Test at any time during the event with the exception of those collars designed to curb barking which may be worn by a dog while kenneled.
- **Meals:** There will be no food available at the test site. Food is available in the Merrickville area.
- **Indignities to Judges:** CKC Hunt Test Rule Section 20.7 – “It shall be the duty and obligation of the test-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. On report of the test-giving Club of an alleged indignity of any kind, the Hunt Test Committee of the Club shall forthwith conduct an investigation and shall at once render its decision to the parties concerned. It shall also, within twenty-one days after the test, report to the Canadian Kennel Club the nature of the alleged indignity, the names of the parties concerned and its findings. The Discipline Committee of The Canadian Kennel Club shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this rule has been violated. A copy of this rule shall be prominently placed in every premium list.” BY ATTENDING this test, competitors and spectators acknowledge that the Eastern Ontario Retriever Club, test officials and the Landowners involved do not accept liability for any loss, damage or injury incurred by exhibitors, dogs or spectators.
- **RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION OF LANDOWNERS AND THE EASTERN ONTARIO RETRIEVER CLUB:** Competitors agree to hold the organization, its members, officers, and directors, the Canadian Kennel Club, and its officers and directors, sponsors of the event, owners of the premises upon which the event is held, and their employees, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while on the premises or grounds of the tests, and competitors personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim, and further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death, or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury be caused, or allege to be caused by the negligence of the parties aforementioned, or by negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes. Competitors assume the sole responsibility for, and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefore, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves) or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injuries, death, or damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties, their employees or agent, or any other person. The personal information provided as a competitor will be used to administer these events in accordance with the CKC rules governing the events. By signing your entry form, you consent to the information described herein.
